QUICK FACTS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Gymnastics Energy has a membership of approximately 1000 athletes each year and successfully hosts 2 competitions a year, including the Chinese New Year Invitational and the Boy's Invitational. These events attract vendors, athletes, and dignitaries from across the province, shining a light on the sport, your children and Niagara.

We have many male and female athletes competing at the provincial level every year. For the 2016-17 year:

- 17 athletes qualified for the Women's Artistic Gymnastics Level 6+ Ontario Championships (results include 1st place champions on Level 6 uneven bars; and 2 top ten all around champions)
- 41 athletes qualified for the Women's Artistic Gymnastics Level 3-5 Ontario Championships (results include 1st place champions on Level 3 vault, Level 4 beam and floor; and 10 top ten all around champions)
- Nine Power Tumblers qualified for the Ontario Provincial Championships
- Two athletes qualified for the 2017 Eastern Canadian Gymnastics Tumbling Championships in Nova Scotia (placing 3rd and 7th)
- Two athletes qualified for the 2017 National Canadian Gymnastics Tumbling Championships in Oshawa

Our competitive athletes also compete at a number of competitions throughout Canada, United States, and around the world.

Our recreational program continues to grow and is loved by many as their first experience to the sport of gymnastics. Parents and Tots enjoy a collaborative program to prepare young one's for new independence and strength. From kindergym to mini stars and the growing in popularity, Ninja Warrior class, Gymnastics Energy will continue to grow and develop programs to suit our community needs with your support.
